

**St. Philip's Church**  
**Native Plant Species Added to Conservation Landscape/Garden**  
(Bestgate & Severn Grove Roads)

**Packera obovata, common name:**  
**'roundleaf ragwort.'** A new native plant species in the garden. One hundred and twenty-six were planted above and below the Bayberry shrubs on Bestgate.



**Solidago sphacelata, common name:**  
**'golden fleece.'** A new native plant species in the garden. Ninety-six were planted below the Bayberry shrubs on Bestgate and new Packera obovata.



**Schizachyrium scoparium, common name:**  
**'little bluestem.'** One hundred were planted across two areas: by the steps down to the sidewalk and among the larger group of existing little bluestem in the middle of the garden, visible from Bestgate.



**Echinacea purpurea, common name:**  
**'purple coneflower.'** Ninety-six were planted to fill in existing areas with purple coneflower. The dried seeds from mature plants will be spread this coming spring to propagate.



**Andropogon virginicus, common name: 'broom sedge.'** Eighty-five additional grasses were planted to the garden to fill in areas that already have broom sedge.



**Rhus aromatica, common name: 'gro-low.'** Twelve were added to the corner of Bestgate and Severn Grove Roads to fill in areas with existing gro-low.
